You guys are amazing. The work you are doing is leaving a great legacy. It is a wonder that you can get to so many places and help so many people.

Speaking for the folks in Derac we are grateful for all that you have done and continue to do. The medicine was appreciated and will be put to good use.

Please note that the pipe has been installed from the deep well to the cistern and from the cistern to the first distribution site in the village.

The pump house foundation is complete and the walls will be done this week. We need to install the pump and pipe in the well before installing the cement slab roof. If possible we will need the pump and generator ASAP. Also Tulio (Anna's foreman would be a great help to install the submersible pump). The project is nearing completion. Land has been cleared along the pipeline and gardening can begin as soon as we have water flowing.

None of this work would have been possible without your support and the fundraising of Dr. Lissa. To our knowledge this is the largest private social impact project to be done in the Northeast Department. Five Presidents could not bring water to Derac but Chuck and Candy Ritzen along with Dr. Lissa are close to reaching this goal. We believe that the clean drinking water and garden produce will greatly improve the lives and health of the residents of Derac.

Thanks for your efforts and sacrifices.
